In addition, this tour features unique accommodation in cabins and bed & breakfasts.

● **DAYS 1 & 2 —**  
● **Arrival in Vancouver**

● Welcome to Vancouver where ocean views, mountain vistas and a thriving metropolitan centre make this one of Canada's most interesting cities. Amidst the lush surroundings, you'll discover rich cultural diversity - whether it's spending time at a popular waterfront market, enjoying lunch on a street side patio or an exquisite dinner overlooking the ocean. World famous parks and natural attractions where you can stroll, hike or cycle make Vancouver a place to remember.

● **DAY 3 —**  
● **Vancouver to Whistler**  
● **(120 km)**

● B.C.'s Sea-to-Sky Highway, from Vancouver north to Whistler, is an elevating experience as you leave the ocean shore behind and travel toward stunning snow-capped mountains. Spend the day exploring Whistler Village, take a gondola ride up the mountain, shop 'till you drop, play a round of golf or just stroll and enjoy the fabulous scenery!  
● Overnight Whistler.

● **DAY 4 —**  
● **Whistler to Clearwater**  
● **(425 km)**

● Leave Whistler via the Duffy Lake Highway, which crosses the Coast Mountain range en route to Clearwater. Your route will take you through rolling hillsides, past the historic Hat Creek Guest Ranch and through the marvelous lake areas of the B.C. Interior. Arrive Clearwater late afternoon and take some time to discover spectacular Wells Gray Park.

● Overnight Clearwater.

● **DAY 5 —**  
● **Clearwater to Jasper**  
● **(315 km)**

● Travel north towards the Alberta border and the Canadian Rockies. Plan to stop at Mount Robson - the highest peak in the Rockies. Consider an optional float trip on the Fraser River which provides an incredible look at Mount Robson and a variety of wildlife viewing opportunities. Arrive Jasper early to late afternoon.

● **DAY 6 —**  
● **Jasper National Park**

● Today, travel through Maligne Canyon and take a tour on the scenic Air Tram or discover one of 800 lakes in the area. Mount Edith Cavell offers gorgeous scenery and views of the Angel Glacier.  
● Overnight Jasper.

● **DAY 7—**  
● **Jasper to Banff**  
● **(285 km)**

● Follow the breathtaking Icefields Parkway from Jasper to Banff National Park. En route, try one of the many scenic hikes or take a Snocoach tour on the Columbia Icefield. Be sure to visit Lake Louise. Take a walk up to the Lake Agnes Tea House or enjoy the splendour of the Chateau Lake Louise.  
● Overnight Canmore.

● **DAY 8 —**  
● **Banff National Park**

● The Canadian Rockies offer some of the world's most spectacular scenery. Spend the day touring the town of Banff, exploring Lake Minnewanka, taking the tram up Sulphur Mountain or take a dip in the famous hot springs.  
● Overnight Banff / Canmore area.

● **DAY 9 —**  
● **Banff to Calgary**  
● **(120 km)**

● Spend the morning savouring the views of the Rockies before heading to Calgary - home to the famous Calgary Stampede. Highlights of this exceptional city include Canada Olympic Park, the Alberta Science Centre and the Glenbow Museum and Art Gallery. Whether it be arts and entertainment, shopping and dining or the great outdoors - Calgary has something for everyone.

● Overnight Calgary\*

\* For those wishing to add on a Two Day Rail Tour Package with the **Rocky Mountaineer**, this night in Calgary will be substituted for a night in Banff.

● **DAY 10 —**  
● **End of Tour**
